

THE DENVER TURNVEREIN, INC.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Approved December 19, 2023

The facilities of The Denver Turnverein, Inc. ("DT") (1570 N. Clarkson St., Denver, CO, 80218), a Colorado corporation, are for the use and benefit of all members and third-party renters, subject to established hours of operation and applicable fees for admission to any DT dance, class or event ("Activity") on or off DT premises. In addition, DT is subject to various requirements in connection with its liquor license. For the safety and security of all, the following binding Rules and Regulations apply to each and every DT member, guest, participant, and employee:

1. Each and every individual attending any DT Activity must be a member in good standing of the DT and pay DT's annual membership fee, as set by the DT Board of Directors ("Board"), subject to any promotional exceptions that DT may announce.
2. Individuals younger than 18 may become members only if their parent or legal guardian consents to and signs the membership form on their behalf. Such signing parents and/or legal guardians are fully responsible for the conduct of their child-member.
3. DT does not permit violation of city any applicable local, state, or federal liquor code or related laws on DT premises or in connection with any DT Activity. Such laws prohibit, among other behaviors, bringing in alcohol or removing any alcoholic beverages from DT's building. Each and every member agrees to provide valid proof of ID at the bar when requested. Individuals under the age of 21 are prohibited by law from consuming alcohol on DT premises.
4. Only appropriately trained bartenders may serve alcohol in the DT building, provided such service complies with all applicable laws. This requirement applies to both DT-hired bartenders and bartenders hired by a person or entity renting space in DT's building for a special event.
5. For the safety of all, DT reserves the right to deny entry or continued access to DT's building to any person who appears to be intoxicated or otherwise disorderly, in the sole discretion of designated DT representatives.

6. Marijuana and all other recreational drugs are prohibited on DT's premises or at any other location during DT Activities.
7. DT prohibits firearms and/or other weapons on DT's premises or at any other location during DT Activities.
8. Smoking and/or vaping of any substance is prohibited in DT's building. Outdoor smoking on the premises must comply with city and state ordinances. Smoking or vaping of any substance outside within 15 feet of DT's front entrance is prohibited by city ordinance.
9. Any individual who causes damage to the physical property of DT shall be held financially responsible for the entire cost of repair or replacement, with all repair/replacement decisions being in the sole discretion of DT. For such payment of itemized repair/replacement costs delivered by DT, electronic delivery is deemed sufficient, as well as delivery by hand or US mail.
10. Each and every individual on DT premises or at DT Activities shall comply with the Denver Turnverein Anti-discrimination and Anti-harassment Policy.
11. All complaints concerning the operation of the Denver Turnverein should be made in writing or by e-mail to the Board of Directors at membership@denverturnverein.com.

Any violation of these binding Rules and Regulations may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination of membership. DT reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to refer appropriate cases to law enforcement. Each and every individual who attends any DT Activity agrees to comply fully with all local, state, and federal laws for the duration of that Activity.
